Before we educate the girl child in particular, let us educate our society in general. Let us give a voice to each child to speak up against anything that is wrong. Let them blossom with beauty and fragrance in mind and body without any looming threat of the Selfish Giant plucking them prematurely and nipping the bud before it blooms. As educationists let our conscience and moral responsibilities be awakened so as to be instrumental in bringing about this change.

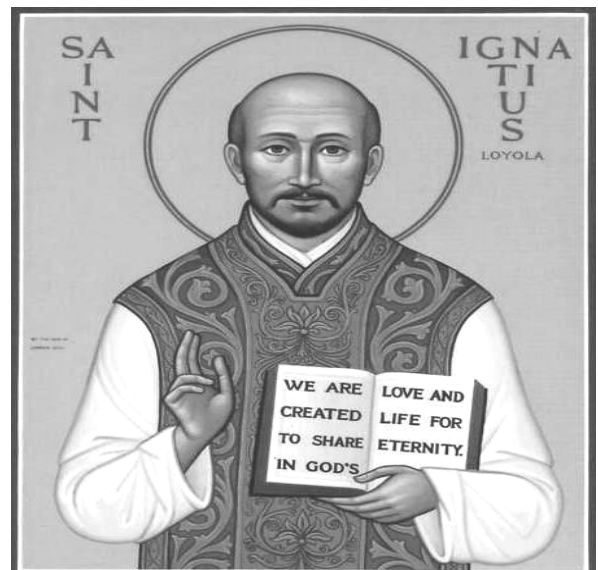
